Both Kunzendorf and Stadtfelde belong to the "Gemeinde"/church of Heubuden.

Unruh's lists of 1808 do not list Franz's wife. She probably died before the family moved to Prussia. However it is possible that she immigrated to Russia with the family in 1805 and died before this list was compiled in 1808. According to the 1776 list of Mennonites in Prussia, Anna could be the daughter of Heinrich from Tiegenhof, a clockmaker, or of Wilhelm, also of Tiegenhof, a threadmaker, or of Isaac a board-maker from Stolzenberg near Danzig - there is no mention of an Oehmsen family near Stadtfelde; cf.1776 cen
