Telegraphic communication from Dalmeny, Saskatchewan, Canada, received by the Rev. D.A. Friesen family here on Thursday of last week, announced the death of Mrs. Wm. Thiessen, which occurred at her home in Dalmeny that day.

Kroeker place one and a half miles east of Jansen and has one daughter (Mrs. D.A. Friesen) and a large number of relatives residing in and around Jansen, and a sister, Mrs. Peter Krause or Margaretha Thiessen Krause, and a good number of relatives in and around Reedley, California. She was the youngest sister of the late John P. Thiessen.

The property near Jansen, according to the papers received was Cub Creek, Township 3 North Range 3 East, Rock Creek, Rihland, Jefferson County, nebraska State.
