Dear Mr. Theissen:

I have just recently been loaned the family history book on the "Mittelburger" family with you as the author. In the book you mention having extensive information on Mennonites in West Prussia born before 1820. This just happens to be my interest as I have been trying to research my family tree (Wieder, Wiegler, etc) and it is the period before 1820's where I am stuck.

My family moved from the Danzig area to Prussia in the early 1600's and I have good records back to my grandfather's father Jacob born in Alexanderthal, Prussia in 1611. Then I was able to obtain the 1630 census of the Mennonites of the Medzschine area of Prussia and in it I have found my grandfather's wife and father-in-law. Her name was Barbara (1611) and with a wife named Anna. I know one other birth registration taken from the same census under the village of Potschen where a Jacob Lauts Weller was born as having a birth certificate from the year 1630 and a few pages back another entry in the same book of a group that survived in 1634. (Opposite side of book). That the old people avoided the plague which would indicate the world had been hit in 1630. I wonder if the Jakob Lauts wife have been born in Prussia and either come with her family to the Riga or came alone.

You probably receive similar requests from India and I would appreciate it if you are no longer willing or able to respond. Just let them know anyway that you could provide me with photos copies of whatever you might have on any witnesses or children from the time of the raid, and particularly who might be the parents and brothers and sisters of Jakob Blatzkis witness. I would be extremely grateful. Please come to mind what names which either that can possibly interest me. The other side has that is all I have of our Free German background.

Incidentally, I do have the family history book called "The Thorell-Der Famby Wrighter" by Frank Wichter of Tremont. I have the feeling that this is one distant wing of my family but have never been unable to make the connection and in my case beyond doubt with Frank Wichter born 1802 and whose father was Farnham Wichter and mother Agnete Funk. I have written to Frank Wichter but he is unable to help me. His book above mentioned has some mention of his brother Frank Wichter. On one page pages 19, 20 and 26 of his book there is a list of a number of Wrichters. One of those listed might be the person you called Frank Wichter. Perhaps you might have information that can help me.

I am off touring my own family pedigree chart see one find one feature. I would be happy to pay you for whatever time and costs you would incur in responding to my request. Looking forward with great anticipation to hearing from you.
