 bapt. Molotschna 1858
 lived in Prangenau, Molotschna, at time of 1st m. 5 Oct 1858
 moved to Tiegenhagen, according to a later notation
 in the 1835 Russian revision list 1846
 lived in Prangenau, per Plett's biography 1858
 lived in Kleefeld (*Brandt Reunion* book) 1861
 moved to Steinbach, Borosenko 1865-70
 emig. from Steinbach, Borosenko, Ukraine 21 Jul 1874
 dep. Hamburg, Germany
 dep. Liverpool, England
 arr. at Quebec on the S.S. Austrian No. 65 31 Aug 1874
 immig. to Steinbach, Lot 4, Manitoba
 d. Steinbach, Manitoba 15 Sep 1909

 immig. to Blumenhof, MB
 lived in Blumenhof, 1874-89; Steinbach, 1889-1916;
 Neuanlage (Twin Creek), 1916-17; Blumenort, 1917-35
 d. Blumenort, MB 11 May 1935
 (2nd marriage to Rev. Peter W. Loewen [1853-1917], 1916)
