 b. Royal Prussia, Poland 1782
 child bapt. when family listed as von die Kamp 1804
 son Heinrich bapt. when family lived in Groschken Kampe
 (west of Frisches Haff, not south of it, as the Zeyerskampen)
 lived in Zeyersvorderkampen, West Prussia in census of 1789
 emig. from Zeyersniederkampen, West Prussia 1803
 immig. to Blumenort, Molotschna, Ukraine (Unruh, 345)
 app. d. Blumenort, Molotschna before 27 Oct 1808
 (Unruh says he moved from Molotschna to Einlage, Chortitza,
 in 1816, but this probably refers to his presumably remarried

 moved to Neunhuben nr. Danzig 1792
 emig. from Neunhuben near Danzig, West Prussia 1804
 arr. Petershagen # 4, Molotschna, Ukraine 5 Jun 1805
 lived in Petershagen # 4 in census of 7 Feb 1835
 d. Molotschna, Ukraine (while living in
 Petershagen # 4, but on the road) 28 Dec 1837
 m. Molotschna, Ukraine (II) 24 Jan 1807
 (1st marriage to Maria Epp [1760-ca. 1804-06]
 in Prussia, 3 Feb. 1798; only child died at a young
 age, but after the 1808 revision)
