 (Jacob Dück married Maria Wiebe [d. 2 Oct. 1774] in Heubuden on 25 Nov. 1773. The church register has a reference to Koldow, probably the home of the groom. A Jacob Dück md. widow Judit Reimer, nee Toews, of Sandhoff on 7 June 1775 and lived in Marienburg at the time. Because there were so many Dücks in the Heubuden register, this needs further checking to make sure that all three marriages involved the same Jacob Dück, although they appear to. No children of any possible prior marriage accompanied the father to Molotschna.)
