 lived in Tiegenhof, West Prussia, in census of  
 (only possible father of Katharina, b. 1751, listed)
848. EDSE, Abraham (?) by 1773  
 d. Neukirch, Royal Prussia, Poland  
 (based on the likelihood that this ancestor may have  
 been the Abraham Eds who was deceased when his son Johan  
 of Neukirch was baptized in Orlofferfelde in 1773, since no  
 other Abraham Eds, except for his son, is listed as the father  
 of any young people baptized in Orlofferfelde in 1773-1804)

852. SPENST, Emanuel (?) (per GRANDMA II) (or Gerhard?) (endnote)  
 b. ca. 1693  
 d. 30 Jul 1760  
 (I had previously identified a Gerhard Spenst who lived in  
 Neuteicherwalde, was a member of the Orlofferfelde church, and  
 had a son born in 1745 as a possibility. The compilers of  
 GRANDMA II have some doubts as to whether there were two  
 successive generations of Emanuel Spensts, i.e., also # 1704.  
 My guess could still be right. It seems quite clear that an  
 Emanuel Spenst was the *Stammvater* of all the Spensts in the  
 Orlofferfelde church.)

 daughter born in Tiegenhagen (per Hilt Friesen) 1784  
 app. moved to Kalteherberge (Plett, v. 6, p. 224) 1793-98  
 emig. from Kalteherberge, West Prussia 1804  
 arr. Orloff # 10, Molotschna, Ukraine 15 Jun 1805  
 d. Orloff (# 10?), Molotschna, Ukraine Mar 1810
