 The first group of Christians of about 228 families left Prussia in 1787 and immigrated to S. Russia.  
 The second group of about 342 families known as the Molotshnaers which included our Tieszen ancestors immigrated from 1800 to 1811 and settled in the village "Pordenau" which was in the Molotschna colony.  
 Peter (b. 1749) was too poor to go along with the immigration, so he stayed 3 more years. During that time he worked veru hard in a wagon factory until he had enough money to buy 2 horses and some food and clothing. In between time he made his own wagon at home and then got married. He and his wife went with another group to Russia.
