All of Abraham's children and their families came over to America. Aaron the eldest came on the SS Kenilworth which arrived in New York on July 17, 1876. He had been preceded by his younger sister and her husband, Sarah and Henry Berg. They came on the Cimbria 1874 with some cousins. The other brother and sisters followed on later ships.

The families settled in a colony like situation in the township of Kimball in N. Jackson County Minnesota
