Henry D moved to Canada with his parents and arrived at Osler Sask in April 1902. They were all sick with diptheria and were quarantined in the railway station upstairs. Three boys died then. After 5-8 weeks they moved to a homestead eight miles west of Osler. Henry spent his youth on the farm and received his education at the Willow Lake School.

They attended the Mennonite Brethren Church north of Dalmeny and Henry was saved during evangelistic meetings conducted by CN Hiebert. He was baptized on Sept 12 1912.

After his marriage he bought 2 quarters of land from his father and farmed it until Jan 1919 when he gave the land back to his father. He sold his goods by auction and moved to Warmen, Sask where he started working in a general store which he later bought in Nov, 1929. He paid \$1800. for the building and \$2500 for the stock. The store burned down later, but he rebuilt it and continued until 1945 when he sold it to Mr Ben Enns for \$3000 and moved to Abbotsford BC on Sept 22, 1946

In Abbotsford he bought a farm on Townline Rd for \$5550. During this time he did carpenter work. In 1954 he sold the farm for \$8800. He bought a home on South Fraser Way for \$6950. On Feb. 15th he sold part of this land for \$1465.

He worked for Dueck Building Supply from 1950-1956 and at Celwood Industries Ltd from 1957-Oct 28 1963.
