H. Penner, Jr had joined the German Army Feb. 1944 to avoid being forced back to Russia. With 5 other Mennonite inductees: Ed Penner, Henry Penner, Peter Klassen, Peter Wiebe & Henry Winter, all now Leamington, his army unit was walking along in Italy when a single sniper shot hit & instantly killed him. His friends buried him there in Gorizia, a village near border of Jugoslavia, 40 kms n.of Trieste. Helena, asphyxiated while sleeping by gases from a basement stove.
