HENRY J. S. SCHMIDT, son of Jacob A. and Anna Unruh Schmidt was born on September 14, 1877 in Greenfeld, Goessel, Kansas and died on the 16th of June 1943 at 7:15 o'clock in the evening at the age of 65 years, 9 months, 2 days. His childhood he spent in the village of Greenfeld where he also received his education.
