

have belonged to the congregation at Heuboden. Nevertheless, I doubt that this was the family in question, because keeping a tavern is certainly incompatible with Kleine Gemeinde beliefs.

(3) Gerhard Dück, b. ca. 1764-66, son of Filip Dyck, who lived in Einlage, Prussia. A Gerhard Dück, son of Filip of Einlage, was baptized in Rosenort, Prussia, on 2 Jun 1793, m. (II) to Helena, b. ca. 1787, and emigrated from Einlage, Prussia, and arrived at Muntau on 4 May 1805. (Source: Unruh) This Dück may have been a brother to # 124 (Peter).

It should be noted that there were two Einlages. The right one was almost certainly the one on the Nogat, which is reasonably close to Rosenort.

But there was also an Einlage on the Vistula. The 1776 census shows a Phil. Dick at Schönau, which is close to this other Einlage.

Note 14: Maria Warkentin was born in 1765 and baptized in Heubuden in 1781. There were two Warckentin families with daughters in Heubuden in 1776.

Note 15: Thiessen suggests that the father of # 106 (Gert or Gerhard) had the same name. Emanuel Spent is almost certainly right for # 424, even if # 212 should be in error.

Note 16: There are numerous Jantzens in the Orlofferfelde church records. Heinrich (# 162) was probably the son or grandson of Peter, Jacob, Heinrich or Frantz, listed in the 1727 peasant census. A Heinrich Jantzen, son of Peter, was baptized in Orlofferfelde in May 1757. This appears to be the most likely candidate, on the basis of age, of the several possibilities.

Note 17: According to The Baergen Heritage, the father of # 92, Elias von Bärge (1742-1808), was Hans von Bärge (# 184) and the grandfather was also an Elias von Bärge. Mike Hornbaker states that the same individual was referred to as both Hans and Elias, in which case there is no information about # 368.

Ulrich Dueck reports that there were two Elias von Bergens of the same period: one, a preacher who lived in Pastwa, the son of Gerhard; the other, the son of Hans. This would tend to confirm that the Elias (# 92) belonging in this genealogy was the son of Hans, because there is no
