Dear Delbert:

It seems I have found the parents of Hans
Keimer and his first wife Maria Epp. I have enclosed
some information from the Danziger church records
for your perusal. Perhaps a close study of the
Petershagen (Tringenhagen) church records might provide
some additional information on Heinrich Keimer or Ignatia Epp.

I don't think Peter Plett (1740-1783) was a son of
Johann Plett (born ca. 1730), perhaps he was a brother. If
he was the son of Johann Plett then there is a 20 year
gap between his birth and the birth of the next son
Michael (born 1761), ~~although~~ although this is possible
it doesn't seem ~~seem~~ very likely. Also Peter Plett
belonged to the Prussian church whereas the Johann Plett
family is recorded as belonging to the Barmalder
Benedict church (Fürstenmender).

I have a record of Peter Plett leaving the Orlofffeld
Benedict church in 1774 for the Barmalder (in the
Barmalder - Barmalder Rosengart Benedict). This is found
in the attestation of the ~~of~~ Orlofffeld church (1778).
Perhaps this is why he is not recorded in the records
of the Barmalder church (which would have been recorded in the records),
that is, he may have been in transit at the time.
