Heinrich Hildebrand (b. 1834) and family came to Canada from Russia on the S.S. Quebec. This ship arrived in Quebec City on July 20 1875. There were 463 Mennonites on board. The group leaders were Isaac ~~Hildebrand~~<sup>Miller</sup>, J. Hoepky and C. Epp of Bergthal and Chortitza in Russia.

In 1880 they lived at Neuendorf, Manitoba  
He owned the following: 30 acres broken, 130 acres unbroken, 2 work oxen, 2 cows, 2 heifers, 4 pigs  
1 wagon, 1 plow, 1 cleaning mill, 1 grain mower  
1 grass mower.

Peter Hildebrandt (b. 1762) came to Russia from Prussia in 1788. In 1802 he lived in the village of Neuendorf in Russia.

In 1802 his family consisted of: Peter Hildebrandt 40,  
Frau Helena 32, Kinder Peter 11, Heinrich 9, Diedrich 4  
Isaac 2

He owned 4 Pferde, 12 Rindern, 55 schafen,  
3 schweinen,  $\frac{1}{2}$  pflug, 1 Egge, 1 Wagen, 1 Spinnrad
