2 Daughter Anna Epp (born 1770) m. Gerhard Linder of
Neumunster, Prussia, in 1792. According to the family history by
S.F. Linder, he was the son of Paul Linder (1701-1765) and
Helena Philipson (1725-1777).²⁶ In 1792 Gerhard Linder married
for the second time to another Anna Epp. According to one source
she was from Neumunster Bergfeld.²⁷ There is no indication that
those wives were related although it seems possible. Nine
children were born of the second marriage. Gerhard Linder was
elected as a minister in 1796. At the age of 25, the family
emigrated to the Molokai Colony in 1800 although the village
of settlement was not given.²⁸
