3 Daughter Maria Epp (1760-1806) married Klaas Reimer (1770-1807) the son of Peterich Reimer and Aganetha Epp of Petershagen.²⁰ At the time of their marriage she was employed as a householder for her aged uncle Cornelius Epp. Shortly thereafter the couple bought a plot of land in Wirtschaff and farmed together with Ohm Epp for a number of years. In 1801 Klaas Reimer was elected as a minister in the Parish of S. Andre and in 1804 he and some 30 of his parishioners decided to emigrate to Russia where they settled in Petershagen in the Melatscha Colony.

In Russia Klaas Reimer led the Kleine Gemeinde reform movement which originally included most of his fellow villagers in Petershagen as well as others. Unfortunately Maria Epp Reimer died in 1806 followed shortly thereafter by her only child Aganetha. Klaas Reimer married for the second time to Helena Friesen daughter of the prominent Abraham von Friesen (1752-1810) clan of Orloff, Melotschna.²¹

3 Daughter Catharina Epp (born 1764) married Hans Regier from Muenchen in 1785. Their Regier/Regier family name listed in Muenchen on Aug 3, 1776 and it is possible that he was the son of one of them. The couple apparently lived in Muenchen after their marriage in the "old town". Their village of origin is the only place recorded. They emigrated to the Melatschna Colony in 1804.²² They may have lived in Muenchen as the name of their children would indicate.²³
