

Section Two. Lehrer Heinrich Epp 1721-1780.

The eldest son Heinrich Epp lived in Neumuensterberg where he served as a minister in the Flemish Grosswender congregation from 1762 until his death. The name of his first wife is unknown. He married for the second time to Maria Wiens of Ellerwald near Flbing.<sup>10</sup> The Konsignation Liste of 1770 shows a Heinrich Epp resident in Neumuensterberg, farmer and land owner of moderate wealth.<sup>11</sup> The family members listed consist of man and wife, three sons, two daughters and one servant.
