

Section Six: Wilhelm Epp

Another son by the name of Wilhelm Epp died in 1791 in Neumunsterberg. A Wilhelm Epp family of medium wealth, property owner, is listed in the Emigration 1776 in Neumunsterberg and is possibly the same. The family consists of man and wife, one son and five daughters. Nothing further is definitely known about Wilhelm Epp or his family.

One special list based on the work of P. H. H. in that Klaus Epp, also called Wolfgang the son of Peter Lager, sometime after 1800 was a son of other relatives of Wilhelm Epp. According to the Emigration 1776 Klaus Epp was born in 1776. Klaus Epp was born May 27, 1810. His father was Peter Lager, and his mother was the daughter of Klaus Epp. Klaus Epp died in 1810. Although a fairly early death, it is possible that Klaus Epp was born in the following family: Peter Lager, born 1776, died 1810. His wife was the daughter of Klaus Epp, born 1776, died 1810. Their children were: Klaus Epp, born 1810, died 1810; and five daughters.

The fact that Klaus Epp had a son Wilhelm claims the possibility that Klaus Epp was Wilhelm Epp. The fact that Klaus Epp was born in 1810 and Peter Lager was born in 1776 makes it possible that another son of Peter Lager was Klaus Epp. The fact that Klaus Epp's mother is listed as Peter Lager makes it possible that Klaus Epp of Peter Lager was Klaus Epp, as of the 1800 emigration records are one and the same. This is possible for several reasons for further study. It is possible that Klaus Epp was born in Klaus Epp's family 1776-1800. His father was Peter Lager, and his mother was the daughter of Klaus Epp.
