Heinrich von Beargen (born 1750), Fischau, Molotschna.

In The Bergen History, Mike Hornbaker has collected a substantial amount of information regarding the family of Heinrich von Beargen (born 1750) as well as various other von Beargen families in Prussia.²⁵ R.H. Unruh lists the family of Heinrich von Beargen emigrating from Neuteichsdorf, Prussia, to the Molotschna in 1804 but does not record the village of settlement. Apparently the family lived in Leske, Prussia, where son Berend von Beargen was born in 1779.²⁶ Mike Hornbaker refers to the work of Carl Stump who reports that this family settled in Fischau.²⁷

The connection to Fischau, Molotschna, is noteworthy as there were a number of Kleine Gemeinde families resident in that village, including Cornelius Esau, Wirtschaft 19,²⁸ and Cornelius Enns, Wirtschaft 13, whose son Heinrich Enns (1801-1881) was the fourth Aeltester of the Kleine Gemeinde.²⁹ Of special interest is the family of Cornelius Fudse (born 1770), Wirtschaft 10, who was married to Helena Spenst (born 1776). R.H. Unruh also lists a Gerhard Spenst family moving from Neuteicherwald to Fischau in 1827. Since Heinrich von Beargen (born 1750) was married for the second time to a Catharina Spenst and the family was listed as being from Neuteichsdorf, there is the possibility that these three families were related.³⁰
