Our Forefather, Kornelius Kornelius Loepp was the oldest son of Kornelius Kornelius Loepp and Agatha (Heidebrecht) Loepp, born on August 28, 1833 in Halbstadt, South Russia.

● He married Justina Giesbrecht, February 12, 1856. Justina Giesbrecht was born August 17, 1836. She died on March 27, 1923 and is buried in Russia.

Kornelius K. Loepp and Justina (Giesbrecht) Loepp had thirteen children: Kornelius, Wilhelm, Wilhelm II, Agatha, Anna, Agatha, Justina, Peter, Agatha II, Justina II, Heinrich, Jakob and Johann.

They lived in the village of Halbstadt, South Russia. Kornelius K. Loepp was known to be a very wealthy, educated man and at one time the mayor of Halbstadt. He received a gold watch from the Russian Zhar, which was later traded in for bread during the Russian Revolution.

Kornelius K. Loepp died May 2, 1916 and is buried in Halbstadt, South Russia.
