Mary, Paul and Christina were there to help. Christina went home to her husband after a few weeks. Paul was on Christmas break, so he was here to help. When he got ready to go back to Stillwater, Frances being very sick at the time, decided she wanted to go to Stillwater with him. Mary, Frances and Paul moved to Paul's campus apartment in Stillwater 12/24/88. Frances got a new doctor in Stillwater. She began recovering. She was so happy there with Paul and Mary in Stillwater. Mary and or Paul would take her around campus in her wheel chair or in the car. About a month before her death, she began having blood in her urine. Her back hurt her from her kidneys. She never had any urine problems. She was always able to use her porta pot. About a week before Frances passed away, Mary and Paul took Frances to the Stillwater Medical Center to have her kidneys checked. The doctor said only one kidney was working. She stayed overnight, and Paul and Mary took her back to the apartment. Mary called Christina, Priscilla and Naomi to tell them Mother was very ill. Christina came to be with Mother a day or so before she passed away. On Saturday morning April 22, 1987, Frances got up. She was sitting in her wheel chair in the front room. Christina, Paul and Mary was kneeling beside her praying. Mary was crying. Frances put her left hand on Mary's head. Mary believes, she was praying for her. Mary was so close to her Mother. Mother knew she would need some heavenly help, when she was gone. Frances did as Jacob. She held all her children and prayed for them before she passed away. Priscilla came to see her in February 1988. Mother enjoyed her visit. We had Mother's birthday dinner with turkey and all the trimmings. Naomi also came several times. April 22, 1989 Frances was resting in her recliner in Paul's campus living room in Stillwater most of the morning. Then around 11 A.M. she needed to use the porta pot. Christina and Mary helped Frances to the porta pot. When she finished, Christina and Mary helped her back to her recliner. As she was sitting down in the recliner, her heart gave away. The ambulance came and took her to the Stillwater Medical Center. The Lord came down in that apt. and took Frances to be with him while her children were holding her. She was such a beautiful mother and friend. She always had something good to say about every one. Frances' body was transported by the funeral home back to Enid. Her funeral was April 25, 1989 in the United Pentecostal Church at 1168 E. Chestnut, Enid, Oklahoma. This is the church she and her husband founded in Enid. The church was packed with friends and family. Frances was buried next to her husband at Memorial Park Cemetery, Section F, Lot 83, Enid, Oklahoma.
