Although all the obituaries, in part, indicate that the place of birth is Karlswalde, the Alexanderwoh Congregation (of which we are members) give the birthplace of my grandfather Benj. Boese as Vola (also Wola). His uncle Benjamin Boese was baptized at Vola.

Since the congregation, the Przechowoka and forerunner of the Alexanderwoh Congregation, always migrated en masse the church records were always taken along. The Prussian era, the Przechowoka records were translated and bound in book form. The Russian has also been translated and is perhaps currently being processed. The first copies have all been sold but will or are being again processed. These two books could be of significant help in the work at the research center.

Since we will be having the first Banman reunion <sup>ever</sup> on September 13, I would be glad to receive a general reaction as to how you perceive the possibilities of further exploration of the origin. By this I don't wish to infer that all the work - research - should be completed by then, merely the possibility.
