

3. Daughter Aganetha Barkman married Peter Fast in 1855 the son of one time Kleine Gemeinde minister and school teacher in Rosenort. See Daniel Fast Genealogy cf. Aft for their marriage the Peter Fast family lived in the village of Tiegerweide where they eventually owned two mills and 12 acres of land which were fully paid for by 1866.67 At this time Peter Fast became a so-called Anwohner Schulz negotiating with the authorities for the landless Mennomites in the Molotschna at the time. "One time he was hauled away and was to go to prison, but he pleaded for grace and had to promise that he would not do this again, and was allowed to walk home".68 In 1867 Peter Fast went to the Crimea, where his brother-in-law Peter M.Barkman later moved, with plans of buying land there which did not come to fruition. In 1869 the family moved to Rueckenau where they bought the Wirtschaft of father in-law Martin J.Barkman.69

In 1877 the Peter Fast family settled in Jansen, Nebraska. In 1880 they joined the K.M.B. Church where he also served as minister. He died at the home of his daughter, Mrs J.J. Thiessen in Reedley, California.70

Note that the Martin B.Fast became the well-known editor of the Rundschau. His wife Elizabeth Thiessen was a sister of Jakob J.Thiessen who married daughter Katharina Fast.71 They were the children of Peter P.Thiessen (1832-1898) of Jansen, Nebraska.72 Daughter Aquaetha Fast married widower Frank Enns of Inman, Kansas.73
