Jacob B. Ratzlaff, son of Bernhard and Susanna Thiessen Ratzlaff, was born January 14, 1890 in Jansen, Nebraska. At the age of 19 he was converted and a few months later was baptized and received into the membership of the K. M. B. Church of Jansen. On January 28, 1912 he was married to Gertrude Doerksen. To this union were born two daughters and one son. In 1913 he was chosen as a deacon and the following year he was ordained to that office. In 1917 they moved to Garden City, Kansas where they lived for 20 years. Later they made their home at Dinuba, California where they joined the Zion K. M. B. Church. He faithfully served the church as well as following the trade of carpentry. He had retired from active work for some time and had not been in good health.
