- X³ - Aganeta Agnes THIESSEN - 1211
 Born - 4 Jan 1885
 Died - 16 Aug 1936
 Note - Aganeta and Susanna were twins. Aganeta was mentally handicapped and spent her adult years institutionalized at Fort Supply, Oklahoma. This information from personal conversation with my Aunt Tillie Harms Buller.
 The old record book in possession of Milton Harms says she was born the 4th of Jan 1885, her gravestone says 18th of Jan 1885. I tend to believe the very old hand written book is correct. I believe the writer is Anna the oldest child of Aron and Anna Thiessen. I believe this because the writer says "Father Aron Thiessen died on the 6 Mar 1899", and in the same handwriting is an extensive record of the children and grandchildren of Uncle Ben and Anna Schmidt. If that is the case, how is it that it has come from my grandparents to my parents and then to me? However it is possible that the writer was my grandmother Katharine. She could have written about her sister's children and grandchildren intending to write about her family later, when her death in 1929 ended her writing. Agnes is buried at Herold Cemetery near Cordell Oklahoma.

 Born - 28 Aug 1887
 Note - Source: Family records consisting of a few very old fragile pages torn from an old note book, folded and stuffed in an envelope, I believe my Mother, Martha Heidebrecht Harms saved them for me. I believe she gave them to me about 1980.
 In summer of 1941 this compiler was 13 years old, my parents with family traveled to the west coast and at that time we visited Aunt Maggie Higgison. If my memory serves me right, she was not very happy to see her nephew, my dad, but did go with to try to find dad's cousin, Bernie Thiessen but did not find him. I have in my possession a picture of the Higgison's home. I believe Mr. Higgison was not living at this time. I know only that they had adopted Margie. A later letter from Katherine Heinrichs Schmidt confirms that Aunt Maggie was unhappy with the family.

 Born - 28 Jan 1895
 Note - Birth day is confirmed from family records, but birth year could not be read in the old record, so 1895 is estimated. Justina married Fred Wall and they lived at Fairbury, Nebraska. Aunt Tillie Buller is source for the above.
 Katherine Heinrichs Schmidt says in a letter that Justina's name was Christina. It seems that these names were interchanged in other instances in my memory. The old record book shows Justina.
