LAST RITES HELD FOR MRS. THIESSEN

Funeral services for Mrs. Isaac J. Thiessen, who passed away early Wednesday morning, were conducted at the farm home and at the Bergfelder church Friday afternoon, in charge of Rev. H. H. Quiring.

Rev. J. H. Ewert, Rev. John Bartel, and Rev. Quiring spoke at the church and a mixed choir sang. Rev. I. J. Dick spoke briefly at the cemetery.

Following is an obituary of the deceased:

Kathrina Thiessen, nee Buhler, was born on March 26, 1877 near Mountain Lake, Minnesota.

At the age of 19 years, in 1896, she was baptised and became a member of the Bergfelder congregation. She was married to Isaac J. Thiessen on November 29, 1896, and until 1918, when they moved to a farm one-half mile east of the city limits, they made their home in this village. Two children, Mrs. Peter R. Klaassen, and John K. Thiessen, were born to them.

The deceased had suffered from cancer for a number of years and in 1928 diabetes also set in. She was taken to Hudson, Wisconsin for medical aid on January 12, 1934 and underwent an operation there several days later. Her condition, grew worse, however, and Dr. H. R. Basinger was called there on January 23rd. Immediately Mrs. Thiessen was taken to Mountain Lake, but life fled at 1:00 A.M., January 24th, soon after their arrival.

She reached the age of 56 years, 9 months, and 28 days, and leaves to mourn her departure, her deeply bereaved husband, one daughter, one son, one son-in-law, one daughter-in-law, two brothers, two sisters, and many friends and relatives.
