Helena Hayek, daughter of Isaac and Katharina Buhler Thiessen, was born in Mountain Lake, Minnesota on February 2, 1898.

On May 20, 1918 she was baptized upon confession of her faith and was received into membership of the Bergfelder Church by Rev. David P. Eitzen.

She was united in marriage to Peter R. Klaassen on January 19, 1922. After their marriage they farmed near Delft and Mountain Lake, Minnesota. Mr. Klaassen passed away on September 26, 1953. While Helena was a cook at the Basinger Hotel in Mountain Lake she met Edward Hayek and they were married on February 10, 1960. Mr. Hayek passed away on July 10, 1965.

On December 18, 1979, Helena became a resident of the Good Samaritan Village. She passed away there on Saturday, January 5, 1980. She attained the age of 81 years, 11 months and 3 days.

She is survived by two step-daughters, Mrs. Albin (Edna) Johaneck of Mountain Lake; Mrs. Walter (Bernice) Fecker of Buffalo Lake, Minnesota; one foster son, Charles Lawrence Peterson of Willmar, Minnesota; one brother, John K.
