JOHN THIESSEN OF CORN DIES

John H. Thiessen, 97, longtime Corn area resident, died Thursday, Sept. 2, in the Corn Home for the Aged.

He was born in Mountain Lake, Minn., and moved to Richmond, Texas, at the age of 19. He married Katy Neufeldt in 1905 and the couple moved to Corn in 1908, where he farmed and ranched.

He served on the Pleasant View school board and on the Corn Bible Academy board. He was a member of the Mennonite Brethren Church where he was a Sunday school teacher and church trustee.

Services were held at 10 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 4, in the Mennonite Brethren church in Corn with Rev. Dan Friesen and Rev. Albert Epp officiating. Burial was in the Mennonite Brethren cemetery.
