

Jennie Voth, daughter of John H. and Katharina Eitzen Regier, was born in Cloquet, Minnesota, on September 15, 1897. She received her education at the Mountain Lake Public School and the German School.

On Pentecost Sunday in 1917, she was baptized upon confession of her faith and was received into membership of the Bethel Mennonite Church where she remained a member the rest of her life.
