

MRS. D. D. (ANNA) SCHULTZ

Anna Schultz, daughter of Peter and Kathrine Nickel Eitzen, was born in Watonwan County, Minnesota on January 25, 1886. She received her elementary education at the country school.

In 1965, when she and her husband celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary, she wrote a testimony in which she related how she came to the assurance of Salvation. She came into this living faith in 1916 when she accepted Christ as her Saviour and confessed him publicly. Later she became a charter member of the Alliance church where she faithfully participated in the spiritual life of the church.

She was united in marriage to David D. Schultz on June 23, 1905 in Watonwan county. To this union seven children were born. After living for six years on the parental farm, they settled on 160 acres of bare land on which they erected their farmstead. They retired to Mountain Lake in 1942. Mr. Schultz passed away in December, 1968.

Mrs. Schultz had been a resident of the Eventide Home since August of 1967. She passed away rather suddenly and unexpectedly on Thursday morning, February 8, at the Eventide Home and had attained the age of 87 years and 13 days.

She is survived by four daughters: Mrs. Cornelius (Hilda) Tieszen, Rochester, Minn., Susan Schultz, Wilmore, Kentucky, Elizabeth Schultz, Burundi, Africa, and Mrs. Robert (Frieda) Ranney, Chicago, Illinois; two sons: Ferdinand, Salt Lake City, Utah and Samuel, Wheaton, Illinois; seven grandchildren, six great-grandchildren, two sisters: Mrs. Henry Esau and Mrs. David H. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, one infant son, seven brothers and three sisters.
