

THE FALK FAMILY

1. PETER FALK \*

Peter Falk was ill the last three months of his life, from January 7 until March 2, 1844 when he died at 8:00 p.m.<sup>1</sup>

On the death certificate of Peter (1842-1922) the name of his father is given as David; however, in a letter to his daughter in 1920, he gives his father's name as Peter.<sup>2</sup> Since the information for the death certificate would have been given in a time of stress by his wife Maria, I've used the name Peter.

PETER FALK \*

Peter and Maria immigrated with their three children to the United States from South Russia. They left Antwerp on the S.S. Nederland and arrived in New York City on August 22, 1876.<sup>3</sup>

Maria was the daughter of Peter and Anna (Penner) Rempel. Her father owned a general store in Russia. After his death her mother married Cornelius Enns on August 21, 1870. Anna and Cornelius immigrated to the United States, arriving in Mountain Lake on February 14, 1876, according to a newspaper clipping of an interview with Katharina Rempel Schroeder on her 100th birthday in 1963.<sup>4</sup>

Peter Rempel, Maria oldest brother, immigrated to Manitoba and from there to Mexico.
