Peter Penner, a brother to Anna, never married and lived to be over 100 years of age.

Abraham Penner, a brother to Anna, arrived in Minnesota sometime before the Peter Falk or Rempel-Enns families as they were already established here and could offer other family members the hospitality of their home as they arrived in this country.

Anna Falk

Anna married Jacob, son of Diedrich and Anna (Siemens) Heppner, who was also born in the south of Russia. After living in Mountain Lake, they moved to Darfur where their four children were born. In 1909 they moved to American Falls, Idaho, and after farming there for eight years moved to Dallas, Oregon.

In September of 1924 they gave up farming and moved to Salem, Oregon and lived at 2240 S. Cottage Street where Anna passed away. After a while Jacob sold the place and built a small cement block house for himself to live in on Broadway Street, then sold this and lived in a rooming house and for a short time in a nursing home.

Helena Falk

Helena married Peter, son of Peter J. and Anna (Koehn) Pankratz. He immigrated to the United States in 1893 and became a naturalized citizen on November 26, 1902.<sup>6</sup> Peter and Helena were married in a double wedding ceremony with her sister Katharina and John P. Eitzen on December 21, 1911. They moved to Montana and homesteaded in the the Lustre community in 1917. Peter died of cancer in 1942; Helena broke her hip March 12 and died on March 19, 1975.<sup>7</sup>
