

Jacob Heppner's (Aunt Anna (Falk)) moved also to Idaho in 1905; Marie Heppner was 13 then. She played with us a lot when she came to visit here. Our folks went to Idaho to visit the Heppner's in 1912 and took my brother Pete and sister Helen along.

Uncle William married Sara Friesen, whose parents lived on a farm 1/4 mile east of the Bergthal Church north of Butterfield where their wedding took place in 1910. After the wedding they moved to Munich, North Dakota. Aunt Sara died of breast cancer in 1924. Shortly after Aunt Sara was gone Uncle William and his daughter Evelyn moved to Grandma Falk's to live with her (in 1925) in Mountain Lake. In 1928, Uncle William died of blood poisoning after a short illness - so Evelyn was left without parents. She lived during the summer months with her Uncle Jake and Aunt Marie Friesen (brother and sister to her mother) on the farm north of the Bergthal Church. In the winter she stayed with my folks (the Stoesz family) and went to high school in Mountain Lake. We lived 1-1/2 blocks from the high school.

Evelyn married Nick J. Hiebert and they had two children. William, who never married and is a minister; and Mary Ann who is married and lives up north. Evelyn died of Leukemia.
