

Helen Falk, 83, was buried from the United Methodist church, Slayton, Friday, Sept. 23 with the Rev. Russell Lindsay officiating. Interment was in Mt. Lake cemetery.

Mrs. Falk was the daughter of Jacob B. and Kathrina Penner, born in Mt. Lake May 4, 1894. She grew up in Mt. Lake and attended high school here.

On Apr. 15, 1915 she was married to David P. Falk at Mt. Lake. The couple resided in Mt. Lake, Westbrook, New Ulm and Redwood Falls. In 1932 they moved to Slayton where she had since resided. Mr. Falk passed away in 1939.
